- Swimming 101 certified
 - o Requirement set by Swim Manitoba

Swimming 101

- Complete the pre-course workbook, in person course & post-course portfolio

Keeping your Swimming 101 current requires 20 PD points within every five year cycle.

NCCP training or evaluation = 5 points

Non-NCCP = 1 point per hour (3 point max)

<u>Active coaching</u> = 1 point per year

<u>Self-directed learning</u> = 3 points max per 5 year cycle

- All coaches in the province of Manitoba (regardless of sport, position on LTAD or athlete demographics) must complete the Respect in Sport
- Sport Manitoba has implemented mandatory recertification every five years

KEY SECTION | National Registration Procedures and Rules - Coaches pages 25 - 28

Masters Coaches fall under Category D and must register annually (Sept 1 - Aug 31) with Swimming Canada prior to actively coaching

Category D - complete one of the following

- Fundamentals Coach (level 1) IN TRAINING aka Swimming 101 IN TRAINING
- Swimming Teacher IN TRAINING
- Community Sport TRAINED (not more than 2 years)

Returning Coaches

- Have until November 30 to become at a minimum Swimming Teacher CERTIFIED or Fundamentals Coach Level 1 CERTIFIED.
- Coaches who plan to challenge an NCCP certification, see next page

New Coaches

- Who start coaching prior to November 30, have until November 30 to complete one of the following
 - Community Sport Coach course to achieve Community Sport Coach IN-TRAINING status



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- Be registered in a Swimming 101 course and complete the Swimming 101
 Pre-Course Workbook to achieve Fundamentals Coach (Level 1) IN-TRAINING status
- Complete at least one of the following: Red Cross WSI / I Can Swim Teacher/Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor and Lifesaving Instructor application to achieve 'Swimming Teacher in-training' status.
- Who start coaching after November 30, have 30 days to complete one of the following
 - Community Sport Coach course to achieve Community Coach IN-TRAINING status
 - Swimming 101 Pre-Course Workbook to achieve Fundamentals Coach IN-TRAINING status
 - Red Cross WSI / I Can Swim/Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor and Lifesaving Instructor application to achieve Swimming Teacher IN-TRAINING status.
- Coaches who plan to challenge an NCCP certification, see below

Coaches who plan to challenge an NCCP certification must

- Submit all of the requirements as part of the challenge process and pay the appropriate challenge fee before November 30th in order to register with Swimming Canada.
- Coaches starting work with a Club for the first time after November 30th have 30 days to complete, submit and pay the appropriate Challenge fee.
